The Clinical Mental Health Counseling and School Counseling Program at Bowling Green State University invites applications for a 1-Year Non-renewable Qualified Rank Faculty – Assistant Teaching Professor in the School of Counseling, Higher Education, Leadership and Foundations to begin August 2023. M.A. degree in counselor education from a CACREP-accredited program with doctoral work in a CACREP-accredited Counselor Education doctoral program is required. Candidates with either a current PhD or are ABD at time of application would be preferred. Work includes teaching and service in CACREP-accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling and School Counseling Program.

- 4. Experience as a Clinical Mental Health Counselor or School Counselor.

- 2. Documentation of effective teaching.
- 3. Experience supervising counselors in training.
- 4. Demonstrated commitment to scholarly activities including research, publications, presentations at professional conferences, and/or grant writing.
